Classes will be held at WHS

Entering Grade 9 Humanities, 10AM-Noon. This class will focus on the transition between Middle School and High School, emphasizing academic language as well as increasing facility with written communication. Students will consider word choice, sentence structure and organization as key components of effective expression. Reading materials will include informational texts as well as the required summer reading for students entering Grade 9 English at Watertown High School in the fall. ***no credit, \$250/5 wks***

Entering Grade 9 Math & Science, 8AM-10AM. Are you interested in getting better prepared for High School math or would you like to improve your math skills so that you will be prepared for Algebra and MCAS? The mathematics topics covered, including reading and writing in math, will depend upon the make-up of the class. Are you also interested in being more successful in High School Physics, Algebra and Geometry? This course will explore working with formulas and collecting/plotting data. We will work on problem solving through word problems and designing experiments. ***no credit, \$250/5 wks***
