2017 Summer Academic Program
July 10-August 17, 2017, Monday-Thursday
For High School Students Entering Grades 10-12

On-Line Credit Recovery. Students may take GradPoint on-line courses for credit recovery with support from licensed teachers. **Students may earn 3 credits with an 80% grade minimum.** This allows each student to work independently at his/her own level and pacing. The content of the lessons has been developed from research-based, proven instructional strategies following the Common Core Standards. Or enroll in a GradPoint class for **enrichment** for fun or to get ready for the next school year.

Entering Grades 10-12 Algebra. 3 credits. Must complete 8 units.	\$345
Entering Grades 11-12 Geometry. 3 credits. Must complete 8 units.	\$345
Entering Grades 10-11 US History A, 3 credits. Must complete 8 units.	\$345
Entering Grades 10-11, US History B. 3 credits. Must complete 16 units.	\$345
Entering Grades 10-12 World History. 3 credits. Must complete 6 units.	\$345
*Entering Grade 10 Physical Science Fundamentals. 3 credits. Must complete 5 units.	\$345
*Entering Grades 11-12 Biology. 3 credits. Must complete 8 units.	\$345
*Entering Grades 11-12 Chemistry. 3 credits. Must complete 12 units.	\$345
Entering Grades 11-12 Health, 3 credits. Must complete 10 units.	\$345
*Science classes do count as a lab science.	

EXCEPT FOR STUDENTS SEEKING ENGLISH CREDIT RECOVERY:

Entering Grades 10-12 English. 3 credits **\$385**
GradPoint number of units TBD. In addition to the GradPoint on-line class, students will be required to complete 6 writing assignments and read supplemental texts with a certified English teacher. Total hours = 2.5 hrs/day (M-Th) for a total of 60 contact hours over 6 weeks.

On-Line for Enrichment. A student works independently at Watertown High School and can start getting ready for the next school year. Why not take Calculus, Algebra II or even Physics. A wide variety of courses are available. *no credit \$345*

SAT Prep Courses. The total price for students enrolled in both SAT Prep courses is \$425.

SAT Math Prep course: Tuesday and Thursday, July 11 - August 10, 8-10AM, 5 weeks. Test prep materials included in tuition. Two hours of homework per session. Content and test-taking strategies will be covered in the course. Students will be asked to attend two additional classes for pre- and post-tests. No credit, \$225.

SAT Reading, Writing and Language, and Essay Prep course: Tuesday and Thursday, July 11 - August 10, 10AM - 12PM, 5 weeks. Test prep materials included in the tuition. Two hours of homework per session. Content and test-taking strategies will be covered in the course. Students will be asked to attend two additional classes for pre- and post-tests. No credit, \$225.

ACT Prep Courses. The total price for students enrolled in both ACT Prep courses is \$425.
ACT Math and Science Prep course: Monday and Wednesday, July 10 - August 9, 8 - 10AM, 5 weeks. Test prep materials included in tuition. Content and test-taking strategies will be covered in the course. Two hours of homework per session. Students will be asked to attend two additional classes for pre- and post-tests. No credit, \$225.

ACT Reading and Writing Prep course: Monday and Wednesday, July 10 - August 9, 10AM - 12PM, 5 weeks. Test prep materials included in tuition. Two hours of homework per session. Content and test-taking strategies will be covered in the course. Students will be asked to attend two additional classes for pre- and post-tests. No credit, \$225.

When and Where: Classes will be held at the Watertown High School for six weeks, Tuesday, July 10 to Thursday, August 17, 8:00AM-10:00AM and 10:00AM-12:00 Noon.

An in-person registration for academic classes will be held in the Watertown High School Library on Thursday, July 6 from 9:00AM-11:00AM. Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis.
